## Policy

Office of the Vice President of Student Affairs

University Housing for reasons of health, normal maintenance, upholding community standards, fire and safety, or to address maintenance of room/dorm necessary repairs to room for health or safety, room furnishings, or room furniture. A search of a room/apartment/suite will be made only with: (1) his or her consent; or (2) a University Search Authorization issued by the Vice President of Student Affairs or designee; or (3) a warrant from a judge, court, or lawfully authorized search.

... give rise to a belief that a search will...

exists. A University Search Authorization will set forth the premises, the person or...  
within which the warrant will remain valid.

A search based upon a University Search Authorization will be conducted by the Boston College Police Department or the Director of Residential Life or their designees and other university officials deemed appropriate in the situation.
